I am writing to express my grave concerns about the proposed Walker Corporation's development of our coastline, the Tasmanian coastline I grew up with. Places such as Ralph's Bay and Crescent Bay deserve to stay as they are not only for us, but for the endangered wildlife whose habitat is on developer's desks as a good place to build. I speak up for those critically endangered species such as the pied oyster catcher and the spotted handfish who feed, rest and breed in Ralph's bay. A 7 - 10 year construction period in these animals' habitat represents an unacceptable risk.

I have not been shown how birdlife and sealife would still be able to flourish and re-number itself in Ralph's Bay with a building proposal such as that of the Walker corporation.
