We are providing this submission in opposition to the Pulp Mill proposed by Gunns Limited in the Tamar Valley.


We object to the proposal on the following grounds:

- The Pulp Mill will be discharging air pollution
- The Pulp Mill will be discharging effluent into Bass Strait
- The Pulp Mill will use large quantities of water
- The Pulp Mill will emit unpleasant odours
- There will be an increase in log trucks and other vehicles putting lives at risk
- There will be an increase in log trucks and other vehicles putting huge strain on current road systems
- Loss of natural forests and water catchments
- Detrimental visual effect of the loss of natural forests
- Detrimental to tourism industry and associated employment
- Loss of lifestyle
- Potential chemical disaster

We live in the Tamar Valley and believe Gunns Limited Pulp Mill will seriously and detrimentally affect us. We are concerned that lives will be in danger and our natural environment negatively altered.
