To The General Manager:

I hope this email is not too late to be considered in the Draft LPS consultation.

I wish to make a representation regarding Rosny Hill Reserve and Wiena Reserve in the LPS.

I am concerned about the future of these Reserves. The draft LPS does not protect these public lands from development. They are used for quiet enjoyment and for the benefit of the plants and wildlife that live there. In the case of Wiena Reserve there is also Aboriginal heritage to be preserved. It is a pity that Rosny Hill is marked for "Urban Densification". If or when other residential areas in the vicinity become densely populated, as seems to be the trend, then the existence of adequate public reserves becomes more and more important.

Would you please rezone Rosny Hill, as NOT for urban densification, and also to a zoning that will ensure protection of its natural values, including plants and native animals, as well as providing respite from the built environment for Clarence residents.

Would you please rezone Wiena Reserve to protect its natural and Aboriginal heritage values, while allowing quiet recreation for residents..
