

Unfortunately we can't provide additional time for submission of the mapping. As it stands our assessment time expires on the 21 March. If the submission is received on the 16th, it will not allow the other parties 7 days to respond to the submission (as specified in our post-hearing directions letter) before a decision has to be made. So if the mapping is not received by 5 March, then it appears that we may have to make a decision without the mapping.

So the options for TasNetworks appear to be that it submits the mapping as soon as possible and see if our assessment timeframes allow the mapping to be considered, or that it decides not to submit the mapping.

Hi Samuel

As discussed yesterday Figure 1 below shows the current Electricity Transmission Infrastructure Protection Code (the Code) which ends at Reece Power Station Communication Site and the Pieman Dam Repeater Communication Site. These communication sites are shown in the blue dots with the Electricity Transmission Corridor (ETC) and the Inner Protection Area (IPA) associated with Line 519 Farrell to Reece shown in the blue corridor.

Figure 2 is an extract from TasNetworks mapping which shows the transmission line extending from the wind farm at near Granville Harbour to the new Pieman Switching Substation. The ETC and IPA associated with this line needs to be included into the Code Overlay as does the Substation Facility and Substation Facility Buffer Area associated with the Pieman Substation.

I have provided more information regarding this in the representation.

We are currently producing a shapefile which will be sent to the Commission for Tony Davidson to update the Code layer. I am hoping to have this shapefile completed in the next two weeks.
