Good Afternoon,

Please consider the following input, as a Submission for Consideration:

1. How will any ceremony conducted at the Tasmanian Cenotaph be treated with the respect and dignity for our fallen, if the MPMS is built? Will the Tasmanian Government not allow any activity which would encroach on any ceremonial day ie: ANZAC Day? It is truly un Australian and un Tasmanian to allow noise, crowds, extra traffic as an example to interrupt or disrupt respect for all Tasmanian men and women who have served this great nation.
2. How will extra traffic be managed if the MPMS is built? Where will the thousands of cars be parked? If bus services are provided how will the end of the Brooker Highway and Davey Street be managed with the massive influx of traffic?
3. Why was there not other sites taken into consideration? In a procurement environment surely three areas should have been evaluated and the best site procured under all due diligence management – if this was not the case why not? Where have the transparency, due diligence and procurement principles applied?
4. How much will the MPMS cost in total? Not just estimate but the whole cost at completion? Can the Premier please explain why and how this enormous amount of money was not utilised on Tasmanian health, housing, rural Doctors and medical services and road upgrades. How can the Premier justify this unnecessary cost?
5. In the current frame how will all the building supplies be brought to Tasmania? Where will all the required trades people come from, where will they be housed? Why is the current Government not taking care of Tasmanian's first? If building supplies and trades people can be easy obtained for MPMS why are they not being brought to Tasmania to build the housing required not just for the homeless, women escaping from domestic violence or simply housing required for the growth of Tasmania.
6. Why is sport taking first priority? Why is the Premier not looking after Tasmanian's first?
7. Who makes the final decision on whether MPMS goes ahead?
8. All documentation in relation to MPMS is to be made public and not hidden under Commercial-In-Confidence caveat/s.
