**State Road Network** 

Zoning of the State Road Network

The majority of State Roads have been zoned Utilities, consistent with the State Road Casement layer and with UZ I of Guideline No. I.

State Growth has reviewed the Utilities Zone in the draft LPS and has identified a small number of acquisition parcels, that are not included in the State Road Casement, but form part of the road corridor and should be included in the Utilities Zone (see Table I below).
