To Circular Head Council,

Thank you for this opportunity to provide comment on the draft Circular Head Local Provision Schedule (LPS).

The LPS has zoned reserved land Environmental Management, including informal crown land at Seven Mile Plains and Marcus River as previously discussed with Council. It is agreed that this is the most appropriate zone for reserved land.

It is also agreed that the shack communities in the Arthur Pieman Conservation Area be zoned Landscape Conservation. This zone is suitable as it protects the landscape values of the surrounding reserve and restricts residential development and subdivisions.

The only recommended change would be to zone the Duck River Conservation Area entirely Environmental Management. The extractive industry could continue to operate as usual in the Environmental Management zone. In the event mine closed, the proposed 'Rural' zone could compromise reserve management in the future.
