Central Highlands draft Local Provisions Schedule

I write in response to the directions schedule provided to Aboriginal Heritage Tasmania (AHT) by the Tasmanian Planning Commission. In response to direction 1.2, I can advise that the Record of Advice document has been partially implemented as of 20 June 2022, with the remainder of the implementation expected to commence in the next few weeks. At the latest, full implementation would occur by the end of July 2022. Please also note that as of 1 August 2022 Aboriginal Heritage Tasmania will move to the Department of Premier and Cabinet.


I further note that page 2 of the directions schedule refers to the Record of Advice as a 'certificate'. I would like to clarify that the document is a non-statutory record of advice provided by AHT, rather than a certificate. I recommend this wording is modified.
