10. On page 72, add the following text as a third footnote after Table 2 in reference to the park area (ha) figures for Governor Island, Ninepin Point and Tinderbox Marine Nature Reserves:

“\*Note: the figure for Governor Island is taken from the 2022 data from the Collaborative Australian Protected Areas Database (CAPAD). The Land Information System Tasmania (LIST) Marine Reserves dataset reports the same area as 56 ha. Similar (<5 ha) discrepancies between CAPAD and LIST are also noted for the Ninepin Point and Tinderbox Marine Nature Reserves.”
