Conservation.

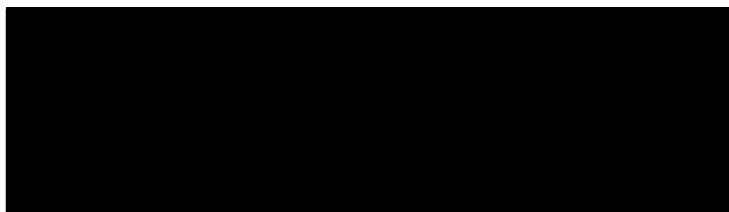
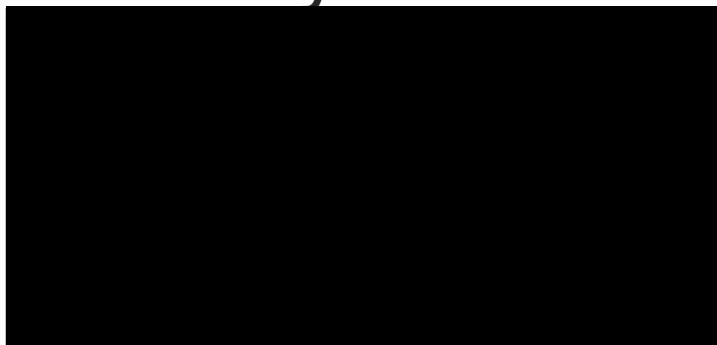
[REDACTED] purchased from
