Thank you for your letter dated 2nd April 2026 regarding the Irenc Report commissioned by the Kingborough Council.

The report is very thorough and applies great logic and common sense.

My husband Aaron and I strongly support the Ireneinc Report recommendation that our property at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Kingston, be included within the **Rural Living Zone (RLZ)**, NOT the Landscape Conservation Zone (LCZ). This is because, as outlined in the report, it's primary purpose is residential (existing house has been there for 18 years), it's cleared paddock land with grazing animals, and it has no identified landscape values or bushland / native vegetation.
