I am writing this email to you because I am a resident and ratepayer within the Sorell council, and I have great concern over the proposed residential development in the existing natural environment area, on Bally Park Rd, Dodges Ferry.

This small area of natural vegetation is so important for the residents of this area...it holds mature native forest trees, native orchids, and wildlife habitat ...not to mention the pleasure of the privacy and uplifting forest views this area affords, between the residential streets here.

Houses built here would not have a sea view as it is in a low-lying area...I have often noticed on my winter walks that the cold air and frost sits here in this lower area when the more elevated surrounding streets are warmer and free of winter frost. Therefore it is not a very attractive place to have a home, but has great value as it is, an area of native forest and environmental conservation. So many trees have been felled in the Dodges

Ferry area, to make way for new housing...it is tragic to witness that, and detracts from the beauty of this special coastal area.

I have made contact with the local Landcare group and other environmentally-minded local residents in the hope that they will agree with me that this area needs to be conserved and that a residential subdivision here is not something to be considered ... please say 'no' to this developer and show the residents of the Sorell council area that you have their wellbeing at heart, and care about the natural environment we share here in this beautiful coastal village at the ends of the earth...
