Huon Valley Draft Local Provisions Schedule (LPS) Direction - land at 971 Lonnavale Road, Lonnavale - Representation 56

The Commission recently concluded hearings on the Huon Valley draft LPS and is now reviewing the matters heard. At the hearing on 27 April 2023, the Commission heard from the planning authority that it was prepared to consider whether part of your land, specifically the cleared area on the eastern side of the property, should be included in the Rural Zone. I therefore write to seek your opinion on the proposed split-zoning.

The diagram below shows a proposed split-zone boundary, which has been prepared using recent aerial photography of the land.




Diagram showing proposed split zoning of land at 971 Lonnavale Road, Lonnavale folio of the Register 112834/2

A 'split zone' is a term used to describe the circumstance where two zones are applied to a single property. In this proposal, the Landscape Conservation Zone would continue to apply to the vegetated portion of the land and the Rural Zone would apply to the north-west corner to allow rural activities to be undertaken.

It would be appreciated if you could provide your response in writing, by email or letter, by **22 April 2024**.

Please note that confirmation or otherwise of your agreeance to the change of split-zoning does not necessarily confirm the Commission will alter the zone of the land.

The Commission will release the decision on the entire Huon Valley LPS in due course.
