I write in support of the Ireneinc proposal for my land and home to be in a Rural Living zone.

This I believe is very similar to what it currently is.

A problem I believe with the Landscape Conservation category apart from potential restrictions on what we can do with our land, is that the landscape is changing naturally anyway.

Most of the landscape is in fact post '67 bushfire regrowth and as it matures it is changing. I have evidence from stumps on my land of eucalyptus trees up to 1.5m diameter at the base.

Without any intervention on my part, the small eucalyptuses are dying and naturally thinning out, and much of the understory scrub is vanishing.

The majority of my neighbours live here because of the natural environment and have no intention of subdividing or changing anything.
