I have received your letter regarding Planning Scheme changes. In it you erroneously contended that I did not make an original submission before the cut-off date which is not correct. Perhaps some submissions have been lost.

I would like you to re-assess the proposed change from Landscape Conservation to Rural. The large block in front of me, the balance at [REDACTED] is designated nature reserve by Council itself in DAS-2006-53.

After that designation I approached Land for Wildlife to assess my land in order that it become a buffer zone to that large tract of land. The Land for Wildlife Agreement was entered into in December 2010.

The entire area of both blocks is existing intact forest. It would be a shame if Council changed the designation to allow future changes to that forested land. It is currently a significant refuge for native species and a much-loved recreational area for local residents who walk in the forest.

Please keep the existing designation.
