Here are my suggestions;

- I live in a street of one storeyed houses. I would request that no one should be allowed to add a first floor onto their existing home as it would block out the sun and remove the privacy from immediate neighbours.
- No multi-storeyed homes should be allowed to be built in a street of low-rise homes.
- There should be no tower block type hotels built in the CBD of Launceston such as that proposed by the Gorge Hotel. They would be completely out of place and ruin the ambience of our heritage architecture which makes us unique and which is the drawcard for many of our visitors.
- The move of the university to the CBD should never have been allowed.
