## CENTRAL HIGHLANDS LPS INCLUSION OF SCENIC PROTECTION CODE

We are new investors in the Central Highlands area and have just been advised of the above hearings. We are thus requesting (on a last-minute basis) our inclusion in the hearings scheduled for 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> May 2022.
