Macquarie Point Multipurpose Stadium Project of State Significance Draft Integrated Assessment Report

The Panel of delegates of the Tasmanian Planning Commission has prepared a draft integrated assessment report (draft IAR) concerning the Macquarie Point Multipurpose Stadium Project of State Significance.

The draft IAR, and the submissions the Commission has received from Hobart City Council and relevant agencies will be placed on public exhibition at the office of the Tasmanian Planning Commission at **4pm on Monday 31 March 2025**.

The office is at Level 3, 144 Macquarie Street, Hobart.

The draft IAR and the submissions will also be published on the website of the Commission and be available to be viewed and downloaded from **4pm on Monday 31 March 2025**.

The project concerns the following:

- A proposal by the Crown, in right of Tasmania, for a stadium to be developed on an area of land at Macquarie Point.
- The project includes, but is not limited to, the development and construction of:
 - (a) a stadium that is suitable for a range of entertainment, sporting, cultural, corporate and community uses; and
 - (b) the related infrastructure and services necessary to support the stadium and its operations; and
 - (c) a public concourse adjacent to the stadium; and
 - (d) any other facility or thing necessary, or convenient, for the implementation of the project.
