ACCESSING SPATIAL DATSETS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DRAFT LOCAL PROVISIONS SCHEDULES

Purpose

This information sheet is issued by the Department of Justice, Planning Policy Unit (PPU) to provide information to local government on accessing the spatial datasets on the Land Information System Tasmania (LIST) for the preparation of draft Local Provisions Schedules (LPSs).

Accessing Spatial Datasets

The PPU have made a number of spatial datasets available to support the preparation of draft LPSs. They are:

- Land Potentially Suitable for Agriculture Zone
- Potential Agricultural Land Initial Analysis
- Electricity Transmission Infrastructure Protection Code Overlays
- Waterway and Coastal Protection Area Guidance Map
- Future Coastal Refugia Area Guidance Map
- State Road Casement

These datasets are shared with councils via Land Tasmania's secure HTTP download service.

Councils already use this service to obtain updated LIST, TASMAP and TasWater GIS datasets that are provided on a regular basis to support the core business activities of councils. The supporting files are made available in a folder called "PPU_Local_Provisions" under each of the council's respective logins.
