RE RESPONSE TO DIRECTIONS

Thank you for the Commission's directions as a result of the directions hearing for the Draft Meander Valley Local Provisions Schedule.

These directions require the following documents referenced in our submission to be submitted to the Commission by 17 May 2019:

- (a) the Environmental Management System endorsed by the Forest Practices Authority;
- (b) the Reserve Activity Assessment - Electricity Entities Operation Plan.

As discussed with your planning adviser, Luke Newman, after considering the Council's response, TasNetworks does not intend to pursue the aspects of our representation that reference these documents. As a result, it is not intended to submit this information as part of this process.

For clarity, the following aspects are those TasNetworks no longer intends to progress:

In order to ensure alignment between other statutory exemptions regarding vegetation clearance and planning scheme exemptions, do not apply the Priority Vegetation Overlay of the Natural Assets Code to TasNetworks assets.	<p>Taking into account Council's response to this request, TasNetworks will not pursue this aspect of its representation with the following exception:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Where there is evidence that a site containing TasNetworks assets has been cleared. Where this applies, TasNetworks will provide information to support this at the hearing on 23rd May.
