Hi Martin,

Thank you for the opportunity for TasWater to provide comment on Meander Valley Council's Draft Local Provisions Schedule(LPS).

TasWater would like to make the following representation under Section 35E of the Land Use Planning Approvals Act 1993.

Whilst generally supportive of the Draft LPS, TasWater request that the following additional land parcels be given the zoning of "Utilities":

As all of the above infrastructure is classified as major "Utilities" within the State Planning Provisions, TasWater are of the opinion the land parcels should be zoned accordingly.

For clarity of an exception to the above, there is an anomaly at Exton where we have a redundant small reservoir on a TasWater land parcel (147108/1) with an active small reservoir on a private land parcel (110262/1) adjacent. Given the small size of the reservoir and the fact it is contained on a large private property, with an undefined boundary around the reservoir, TasWater do not see a need to have either our land parcel or the land around the active reservoir zoned as Utilities. A map is attached to this email to show this situation visually.

TasWater is satisfied that all other "Utilities" owned and operated by TasWater are zoned appropriately.

TasWater would also welcome an invitation to attend any subsequent Tasmanian Planning Commission hearings if required to clarify or expand on this represention.
