Hi,

Thank you for inviting Marine and Safety Tasmania (MAST) to make a representation on the *Draft Assessment Criteria North East Wind Major Project June 2023*.

The draft proposal indicates that consideration may be given to the development of a wharf to allow for transportation of materials to the site by sea. MAST considers it would be appropriate for any arrangements involving shipping operations in a new location to be clearly detailed and considered as part of the assessment process. Therefore, for the purposes of clarity, it may be beneficial to expand clause 4.1.1 of the *Draft Assessment Criteria North East Wind Major Project June 2023* to articulate that the transport methods considered include marine transportation, with the context and assessment criteria being expanded to include an additional point:

- *the design, location and management of permanent and temporary marine infrastructure that may be used in association with transportation by sea of material and equipment to a site access point.*
