Your comments : Circular head never ceases to inspire, with views from unexpected places taking people by surprise. A classic example of that is tourists going to visit Dip Falls, and on the return coming around a corner and seeing the Stanley nut in all its glory. Three items that make up many of the views are iconic to circular head, and should be protected from incursions of ugly landscapes and constructions at all costs. These are The Stanley Nut, Preminghana (Mount Cameron) & the main peak on Three Hummock Island. My belief is that the general population of circular head do not want large structures, and generally oppose applications for building things that would be out of place. When the Woolnorth Wind farm was built, there were a small group of objectors, I would suggest if the council was to approve a wind farm on Cape Grim today, there would be a general uprising and mutiny. On the rural side, I do get disappointed in the continuing removal of native eucalypts, and there replacement with hedge trees such as Casawellan Gold pines. It would be good to encourage farms to keep screening trees and shelterbelts, and to plant natives in new shelterbelts.
