Integrated Assessment for proposed Stadium at Macquarie Point

I am a social worker with many years of experience in community organisations and community development. I have seen the destructive effects on individuals and communities of selfish, thoughtless and greedy planning and building decisions. That is one of the reasons I am concerned about the proposal for a new stadium at Macquarie Point and about the current process of so-called 'consultation' over a too short, too busy time.

I have read and fully endorse the submission made by Our Place - Hobart.

I am concerned about a number of aspects of the current proposals including the high-handed bullying of the AFL - for whom no Tasmanian has ever voted - apparently determining what has to provide to them for a token payment. The AFL demanding a roofed stadium in the second driest capital city is but one example of the extent to which Tasmania is regarded as a mere plaything by a disconnected cadre. Let's put ourselves into an international setting by supporting soccer development - that has no major space to attract games and competition, unlike AFL with two, covering the state more fairly.
