**Integrated Assessment for proposed Stadium at Macquarie Point**

I am opposed to the development of any stadium at Macquarie Point for multiple reasons. It will be underutilised and lose money. It will cause traffic chaos as Hobart does not have the parking facilities or public transport infrastructure to support major events in the CBD. Funds could be better spent on housing and health. A stadium here will disadvantage York Park in Launceston, and devalue the investments of time and money made in this facility.
