Dear Minister,

Macquarie Point Multipurpose Stadium - Project of State Significance Assessment

The Macquarie Point Multipurpose Stadium was declared a Project of State Significance in accordance with the *State Policies and Projects Act 1993* (the Act), on 16 October 2023.

By Direction of the former Minister, of the same date, the Tasmanian Planning Commission was required to prepare an integrated assessment of the Macquarie Point Multipurpose Stadium proposed for Macquarie Point, in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

The Direction of 16 October 2023 required the Commission to submit its report of the integrated assessment to the Minister within 12 months of the submission to the Commission, of documents by the project proponent, which responded to integrated assessment guidelines prepared by the Commission.

On 21 November 2023, in accordance with usual practice, the Commission delegated the integrated assessment to a five person independent expert assessment panel.

The proponent's reports in response to the guidelines were received by the Commission on 17 September 2024.

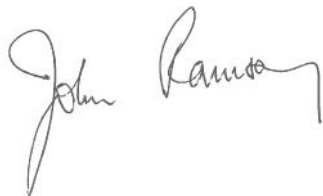
The assessment panel has now completed its assessment and prepared a Recommendation Report on the Project as is required by section 26(1) of the Act.

The Panel has also prepared a comprehensive Integrated Assessment Report which is to be read in conjunction with the section 26(1) Report.

In accordance with section 26(1) of the Act, the Commission submits the Reports for your consideration.

Section 26(3) of the Act requires the Commission to publish notice of the Commission's report to you in the Tasmanian Government Gazette and to make the reports publicly available. This will occur between 9:00 - 9:30 am on Wednesday 17th of September 2025.
