- 17 years owner & resident at [REDACTED], Mornington
- The traffic from Pass Road and Cambridge Road, has greatly increased over that time with delays morning and night.
- At peak times access to Cambridge Road from [REDACTED] is very busy.
- Mornington roundabout is so busy and clogged from 7.30 am - after 9am from Pass & Cambridge Road.
- Mackillop College has increased student numbers due to offering Years 11 & 12.
- Traffic from Pass Rd and Cambridge Road has required the traffic to form 2 lanes before Currajong St meets Cambridge Road.
- This is so busy and congested especially with the Bus Stop located between Currajong St and Mornington roundabout.

I wish to oppose the amendment due to the significant burden on traffic that will be put on to Pass & Cambridge Road including the Mornington roundabout. Proposed new subdivision road from Cambridge Road will add a new danger zone with traffic from Pass & Cambridge Road as well as the bus stop between 471 Cambridge Road & Joshua St Mornington.
