

# Assessment of projects of state significance

Part 3, State Policies and Projects Act 1993

Initiation

Minister recommends an order declaring a project is of state significance

Guidelines

Governor makes the order in accordance with the recommendation

Both Houses of Parliament must approve the order

Minister directs the Commission to undertake an integrated assessment of the project

Assessment

Commission notifies all stakeholders

Commission prepares a draft integrated assessment report

Commission holds a public exhibition for 28 days and invites and receives representations

Commission may hold a hearing

Public exhibition

Commission may hold a public hearing

Reporting

Commission may modify draft report

Commission submits Final Integrated Assessment Report to Minister and recommends whether project should proceed and publishes notice of its report

Tasmanian Government Premier
