Proposed Draft Planning Directive

Dolphin Tungsten Mine, Grassy - King Island Interim Planning Scheme 2013

I refer to the Commission's letter dated 7 July 2023 and the request by Group 6 Metals Limited to the Commission, dated 26 June 2023, seeking a draft planning directive to apply to the Dolphin Tungsten Mine at Grassy, King Island.

The Commission recommended that an assessment of the draft planning directive should be undertaken, and that an interim planning directive in the form of the draft planning directive be issued. The Commission also provided some tracked changes to the submitted draft planning directive to ensure it may operate technically in the setting of the interim planning scheme, and to clarify the spatial extent of the attenuation area for the Dolphin Tungsten Mine at Grassy (measured 2000m from the lot boundary).

The purpose of this letter is to provide further revisions to clarify the spatial application of the draft planning directive (see Attachment 1). These changes are editorial in nature and continue to reflect the Commission's recommendation that an assessment of the draft planning directive be undertaken.
