I am writing to you to voice my serious concerns about the proposed upgrade to the electrical towers that currently track through the Romaine Reserve.

I have grave reservations about the major financial effect to the resale value of my home, but far more importantly, the health risks that may be attributed to such a major voltage increase to these towers in a closely populated area.

My property backs directly onto the reserve and have felt pressure, as I am sure others have, from a major corporate company to sign and comply with their terms, which I certainly do not.

I believe there could be potential environmental offences (pollution of air, water, land) and or civil claims like “nuisance” or “negligence.”
