Thank you for your letter dated 2 April 2026.

Myself and my wife are extremely happy to read that our property [REDACTED] Kettering is recommended in the Ireneinc report to be included within the Rural Zone.

In the submission made on our behalf to The Tasmanian Planning Scheme, I also expressed our concern that our adjoining property [REDACTED] (currently zoned Rural resource) was proposed in the Kingborough draft LPS to change to Rural Living C.

Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] operate as one property with all the farm infrastructure (sheds, yards etc) on [REDACTED] and the main farm house on 297.

It therefore makes sense that these two properties remain rural.

All our neighbours, including [REDACTED], (once the 3rd title of the farm under previous owners) are to change/remain Rural. It should be noted that [REDACTED] was also proposed under the Kingborough Council draft LPS to be zoned Rural Living C but is now recommended to be Rural.
