I have read correspondence that your office forwarded to me on the the 2 April 2026 (DOC/26/36829).

From what I can tell, it is proposed that our property will be zoned "Landscape Conservation". It is also my understanding that the consultant planners have recommended that it be zoned "rural".

This property was purchased by us in 2025 after lifetimes of public service in rural and remote Australia. It has always been our dream to own a small holding upon which we can grow vegetables and run some animals. Although we do not see it being a large commercial enterprise, it was out intention to supplement our pensions with whatever we are able to produce.

In this regard, from what I can glean from the document, it would seem that zoning our property as 'landscape conservation' could have a deleterious affect on our plans and, furthermore, or future income.

I therefore respectfully request that the recommendations of the Ireneinc report be implemented and that our property be zoned 'rural' in order to circumvent any future potential loss of income.
