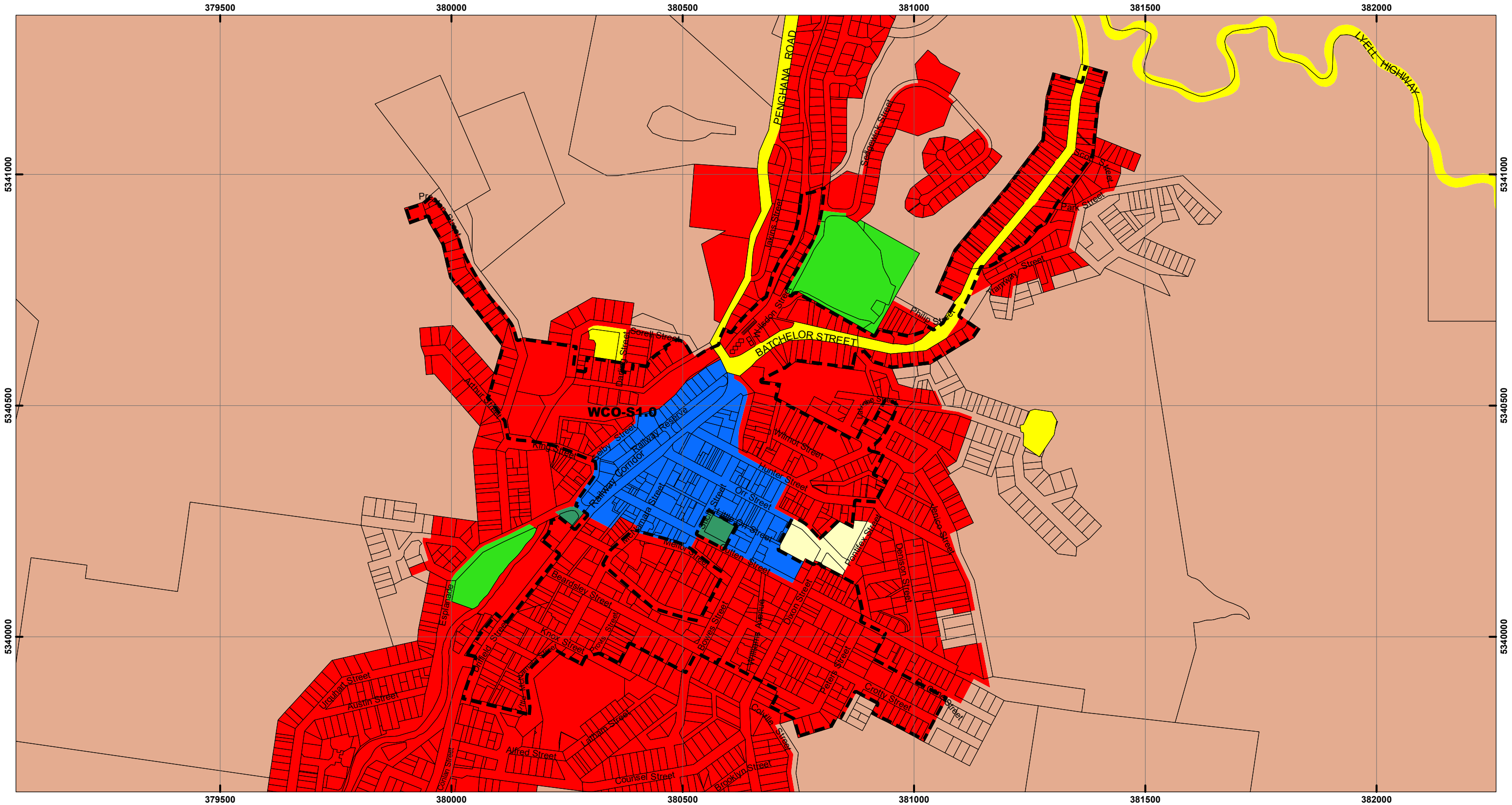


TASMANIAN PLANNING SCHEME - SPECIFIC AREA PLANS: WEST COAST LOCAL PROVISIONS SCHEDULE

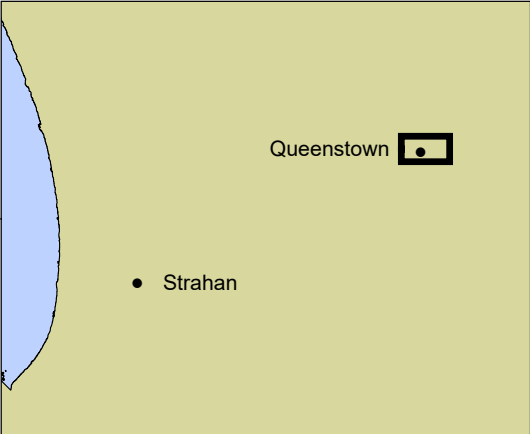

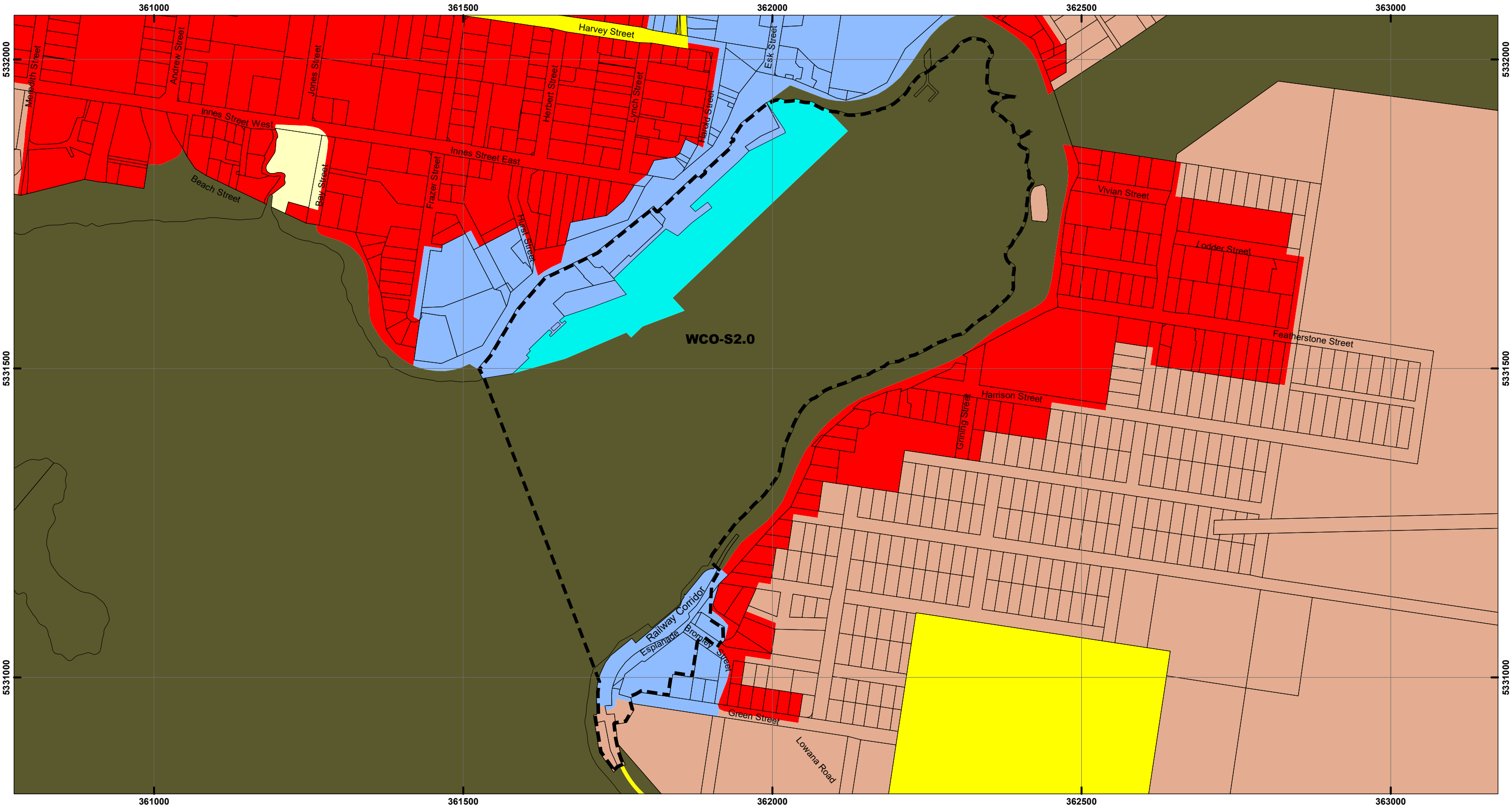
