If there are any matters listed under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*, including habitat for threatened species, that may be impacted by the proposed development, the proponent should make themselves aware of their obligations under that Act.

Both 90-102 Stony Rise Road and one and five Stony Rise Roads are already cleared and are located within a developed urban landscape with existing housing, and commercial infrastructure, therefore it is anticipated that the proposed activity is unlikely to impact listed flora or fauna species.
