RE: DRAFT HUON VALLEY LOCAL PROVISION SCHEDULE (LPS) – LPS-HUO-TPS – DIRECTION 12

I write in response to the Commission's directions issued on 9 August 2023.

Direction 12 requested the following information:

In relation to representation 297 (land at 614 Lady Bay Road, Southport, folio of the Register 121159/1), the planning authority is to undertake an investigation:

- as to whether the Landscape Conservation Zone or the Rural Living Zone C ought to apply to the land; and
- to what extent the Priority Vegetation Area overlay ought to apply to the land.

Response

Priority vegetation and Regional Ecosystem Model (REM) output

- TASVEG maps areas of wet blue gum forest (WGL) along the coastal margin and in the northwest corner of this property.
- Mature blue gums in this area are known to provide significant foraging habitat for the
 critically endangered swift parrot (*Lathamus discolor*) when in flower, and nests for
 the species have also been recorded during Forestry assessments/activities in the
 Lady Bay area.
- The REM picks up WGL forest and associated foraging habitat for the swift parrot.

Conclusions regarding zoning

• The Planning Authority has recommended Rural Living D, relying on the Priority

Vegetation Area (PVA) overlay to provide protection for natural values.

Conclusions regarding PVA overlay

• This property is completely forested and potentially provides both foraging and

nesting habitat for swift parrots, as well as good habitat for a range of other

threatened fauna species. As a result, the PVA overlay should apply to the whole

property.
