Tasmanian Planning Scheme - Devonport Draft amendment AM2022.01 and permit PA2022.0024 133 Middle Road, Miandetta

I refer to the above draft amendment and to a hearing held at the Paranaple Centre in Devonport on 6 and 7 March 2023, which was adjourned.

The Commission gives the following directions:

- 1. Parties may provide to the Commission a submission in response to the applicant's submission dated 2 March 2023 regarding the Greater Devonport Residential Strategy and the Devonport Open Space Strategy by **14 April 2023**.
- 2. The applicant may provide to the Commission a digital version of the book 'A ton of *pennies*' presented at the hearing by **14 April 2023.**
- The planning authority and/or applicant are to provide to the Commission by 28 April
 2023 any response to the submission at the hearing by representors of the notated book 'Devonfield's Wonderland'.
- 4. The planning authority and applicant are to provide to the Commission a joint submission(s) addressing the following matters by 28 April 2023. Should agreement not be found on these matters separate submissions will be received and, if required, the hearing will be reconvened.
 - (a) A map or diagram depicting the location of the northern boundary of the proposed Open Space Zone in relation to the ridgeline, noting that Figure 8 (Revision A, 6 October 2021) in the application report refers to the boundary as generally following the ridgeline.
 - (b) A revised permit with conditions that specify the parts of the applicant's documents that are to apply to the development.

- (c) A map that confirms the boundary(s) of the area identified for the protection of the *Eucalyptus ovata* community and central north burrowing crayfish (*Engaeus granulatus*) habitat areas.
- (d) The natural values assessment and evidence to the hearing establishes a preliminary view that the area defined in 4(c) above should not be zoned General Residential, submissions are invited on:
 - I. the most appropriate alternative zone for this area;
 - II. whether this zone warrants a connection with the proposed Recreation Zone (i.e. lot 7); and
 - III. whether any other mechanisms should be introduced by way of planning scheme provisions and/or permit conditions to protect the *E. ovata community* and central north burrowing crayfish (*E. granulatus*) habitat areas.
- That any response submissions by representors, applicant, or planning authority (following publication of any of the above submissions) be provided to the Commission by 12 May 2023.

Submissions must be made by email to <u>tpc@planning.tas.gov.au</u>. Once received, the submissions referred to above will be made available under the <u>relevant assessment</u>¹ on the Commission's website.

Please note that submissions will be published in full, without redaction.

If the hearing is to be reconvened, the Commission will advise the parties and publish a notice.
