Subject: Bridgewater Bridge Representation

To whom it may concern

I would like to make a representation in regards to the planning/design of the Bridgewater Bridge. My issue/concern is with the slip lane to Black Snake Road and New Norfolk on the Granton side of the river. In the original design (see photo below) the old slip lane was being used to take traffic to these locations therefore leaving No.37 Black Snake Rd and a majority of the trees that surround this property unaffected. These trees create a natural barrier to all the highway noise to ALL residents in Dickenson Drive which is just off Black Snake Rd. In the new revised design/proposal (see picture no.2 bellow) the slip lane is coming through No.37 and removal of the trees will be required allowing all highway noise to be projected on the residents on Dickenson Drive. Also the design in the first proposal kept the volume of traffic traveling off the highway to New Norfolk further away from residents in Black Snake Rd as well as Dickenson Drive. Creating less noise for the residents in the surrounding area. I believe that these issues has not be addressed. If the trees are removed for the slip lane I feel that some sort of noise barriers will need to be put in to replace the lost 'natural' barrier.
