Draft Huon Valley Local Provisions Schedule

This representation is made by David de Burgh on behalf of the Cygnet Bowls & Community Club Incorporated. A letter authorising the submission and signed by the Club President is attached.

At its meeting on 29 January 2020, the Huon Valley Council resolved to initiate draft Amendment PSA-2/2019 to the Huon Valley Interim Planning Scheme 2015. This amendment was to partially rezone 15 Louisa Street, Cygnet (PID 2135267, CT136883/1) to General Residential zoned land.

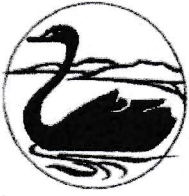
Further, at its meeting on 29 April 2020, following a review of representations from the public, the Council resolved to recommend to the Tasmanian Planning Commission that it approve the amendment.
