The Tasmanian Land Conservancy has made a representation (representation 263); Mr. Ramsay has a prior professional association with Amy Robertson (representations 313, 343, 344, 367 and 368) as both were former members of the Board of the Forest Practices Authority for a period of approximately 4 ½ years. The association ceased when Ms. Robertson resigned from the Board in February 2021. Mr. Ramsay is no longer Chair of the Board of the Forest Practices Authority, having resigned in March 2022, as a result of his appointment to the position of Executive Commissioner of the Commission; and A member of Mr. Ramsay's family owns a small property in the municipality, but is not a representor.
