## Submission to the review of the draft Tasmanian Planning Policies

Thank you for the opportunity to formally comment on the draft Tasmanian Planning Policies (TPPs) under section 12E(1) of the Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993.

The department has previously provided detailed input into the development of the TPPs, focusing on our key portfolio interests of transport infrastructure, services and project delivery, skills, mineral resources, business and jobs, and the cultural and creative industries. We have also provided comments on issues that relate or impact on these core interests, including settlement planning, heritage, environmental values, and planning processes.

The department supports the content of the current draft policies, considering they provide appropriate statewide guidance across each of the seven theme areas, and will support improved strategic planning and decision-making across Tasmania.

We particularly note strategies that recognise the need to protect our major transport infrastructure networks and extractive industry resources, manage landslip risk, support public and active transport, and better manage settlement growth.
